Agency General Provisions

Summary Generally under current law, a town sanitary district commission is required to let all public works contracts that involve an expenditure of at least \$5,000 to the lowest responsible bidder. Also under current law, in general, a county is required to let all public works contracts that involve an expenditure of at least \$25,000 to the lowest responsible bidder, and a city, village, or town is required to let all public works contracts that involve an expenditure of at least \$15,000 to the lowest responsible bidder.

This amendment amends Wis. Stats., 60.77(6) (a), raising the bidding threshold for public works contracts let by a town sanitary district from \$5,000 to \$15,000 before the lowest responsible bidder requirements apply.

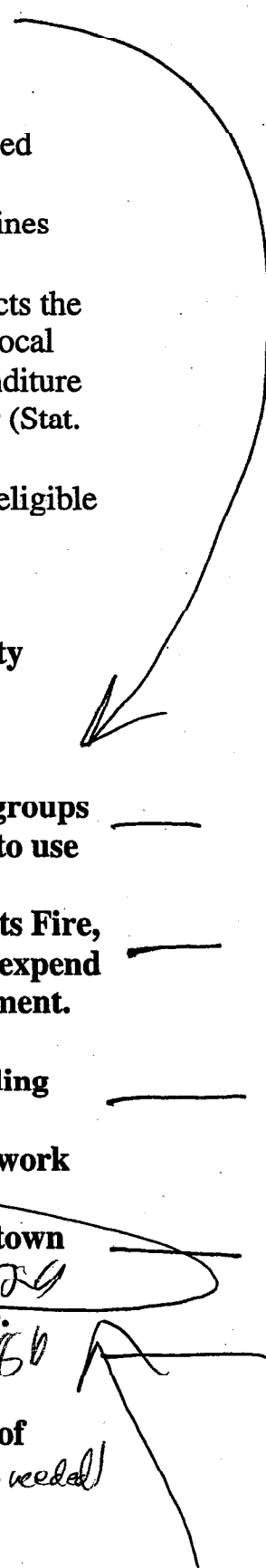



1 **AN ACT to amend 60.77 (6) (a) of the statutes; relating to: raising the bidding**
2 **threshold for public works contracts let by a town sanitary district.**

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Generally under current law, a town sanitary district commission is required to let all public works contracts that involve an expenditure of at least \$5,000 to the lowest responsible bidder. Also under current law, in general, a county is required to let all public works contracts that involve an expenditure of at least \$25,000 to the lowest responsible bidder, and a city, village, or town is required to let all public works contracts that involve an expenditure of at least \$15,000 to the lowest responsible bidder.

This bill increases the bidding threshold for a public works contract let by a town sanitary district commission from \$5,000 to \$15,000 before the lowest responsible bidder requirements apply.
