Summary Prohibit the State Laboratory of Hygiene from providing water-quality testing for a fee that is less than the current average fee charged by private, state-certified commercial labs in the state. Require the State Laboratory to notify a party seeking water-quality testing services if the party is permitted to obtain those services from private, state-certified commercial labs under state and federal law. Require the State Laboratory to consult with not fewer than three private, commercial labs annually to determine the current average fee for each type of water-quality test performed by the State Laboratory.

Fiscal Impact Indeterminate.
