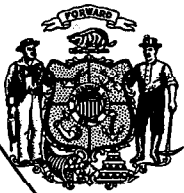

1 AN ACT to amend 230.26 (4) of the statutes; relating to: fringe benefits provided
2 to limited term employees in the state civil service.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, limited term employees are state employees appointed for provisional appointments for less than 1,044 hours per year. These employees do not qualify for any fringe benefits other than worker's compensation, unemployment insurance, group insurance, retirement, and social security coverage. This bill provides that limited term employees may participate in the state's deferred compensation plan. Under current law, the deferred compensation plan is one in accordance with section 457 of the federal Internal Revenue Code, under which a governmental employer executes an agreement by which an employee voluntarily agrees to defer a part of gross compensation for payment at a later date.
