Agency Employment Relations

Summary Under current law, the Employment Relations Commission "labor peace" appropriation receives \$2.6 million over the biennium.

This amendment would decrease the Employment Relations Commission "labor peace" appropriation annually by \$100,000 GPR in 2001-2002 and \$200,000 GPR in 2002-2003. Additionally, the amendment authorizes ERC to establish fees by rule for services performed by the agency that are not otherwise charged under sections 111.09 (2) - UW-Hospitals and Clinics and a few other private employers, 111.71 (2) - cities, counties, towns and school districts, and 111.94 (2) - State of Wisconsin. These include various services like mediation, arbitration, fact finding, and transcripts.

Fiscal Impact Reduces GPR expenditures by \$300,000 (\$100,000 FY01, \$200,000 FY02).

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill ^{g substitute amendment} as follows:

2 1. Page 200, line 4: decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2001-02 by
3 \$100,000 and decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2002-03 by \$200,000 to
4 decrease the authorized FTE positions for the employment relations commission by
5 2.0 GPR attorney positions beginning on January 1, 2000, for the purpose for which
6 the appropriation is made.

7 2. Page 200, line 7: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2001-02 by
8 \$100,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2002-03 by \$200,000 to
9 increase the authorized FTE positions for the employment relations commission by

6 fact-finding, mediation and, arbitration, and other functions and for the provision
7 of copies of transcripts. All moneys received under ss. 111.09 (1) and, (2), (2m),
8 111.71 (1) and, (2), (2m), and 111.94 (1) and, (2), (2m), except as otherwise
9 provided in those sections, shall be credited to this appropriation account.”.
