Summary This motion provides that if a state officer, agency, authority, or governmentally related corporation maintains an Internet site, the officer, agency, authority, or corporation may not use that site to obtain personally identifiable information from any person who visits that site without the consent of the person from whom the information is obtained. Under the bill, personally identifiable information means information that can be associated with a particular individual through one or more identifiers or other information or circumstances. Violators are subject to a forfeiture (civil penalty) of not more than \$500 for each violation.

These provisions are contained in AB 176, which passed the Assembly 97-0.

Under current law, the dentistry examining board (board) includes six dentist and three dental hygienist members and, on December 31, 2002, the number of dentist members is reduced to five and the number of dental hygienist members is reduced to one. This motion eliminates the reduction of members so that, on December 31, 2002, the board includes six dentist and three dental hygienist members.

This bill provides that if a state officer, agency, authority, or governmentally related corporation maintains an Internet site, the officer, agency, authority, or corporation may not use that site to obtain personally identifiable information from any person who visits that site without the consent of the person from whom the information is obtained. Under the bill, "personally identifiable information" means information that can be associated with a particular individual through one or more identifiers or other information or circumstances. Violators are subject to a forfeiture (civil penalty) of not more than \$500 for each violation.
