Summary

Under current law, an agency may promulgate a rule as an emergency rule without complying with the notice, hearing, and publication requirements for regular rule making if the rule is needed to preserve the public health, safety, or welfare. A rule promulgated as an emergency rule takes effect upon its publication in the official state newspaper and remains in effect for 150 days.

This motion would reduce initial duration of emergency rules from 150 days to 90 days and two renewal dates of 90 days each.

A rule must be sent to the revisor of statutes within 30 days of committee action.
