Summary Under current law, a school district's debt service costs are included in its shared cost for the purpose of determining the amount of state aid that the school district receives. Under this motion, debt service on debt authorized by a referendum on or after the bill's effective date is excluded if the exclusion results in an increase in state aid to the school district.

This motion is identical to Assembly Bill 325.

Fiscal Impact This motion has no fiscal effect on state government according to a fiscal estimate prepared by the DOA for Assembly Bill 325. The cost to local school districts is indeterminate due to the unknown effect of redistributing school aids.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a school district's debt service costs are included in its shared cost for the purpose of determining the amount of state aid that the school district receives.
