

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires common and union high school districts to hold an annual meeting at which school district electors may vote on school district issues. The meeting must be held between May 15 and September 30. This bill extends through October the period during which the meeting may be held.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 2.** 120.08 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

 5 120.08 (1) (a) Common school districts shall hold an annual meeting on the 4th
 6 Monday in July at 8 p.m. and union high school districts shall hold an annual
 7 meeting on the 3rd Monday in July at 8 p.m. unless the electors at one annual
 8 meeting determine to thereafter hold the annual meeting on a different date or hour,
 or authorize the school board to establish a different date or hour. No annual meeting
