March 30, 2001 - Introduced by Representatives OTT, KESTELL, WADE, YOUNG, AINSWORTH, OLSEN, LIPPERT, STARZYK, PLOUFF, FREESE, HAHN, TURNER, BERCEAU, MILLER, TOWNSEND, MCCORMICK, POWERS, OWENS, SYKORA and VRAKAS, cosponsored by Senators MOEN, PLACHE, ROSENZWEIG, GEORGE, ROESSLER and COWLES. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 20.255 (2) (cp) and 115.343 (title) and (1); and **to create** 115.343
2 (2) (c) of the statutes; **relating to:** eligibility criteria for and renaming the
3 Wisconsin morning milk program.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under the morning milk program, the state reimburses school districts for the cost of providing milk to pupils in prekindergarten classes to grade five who meet certain income eligibility standards and are not receiving milk through the federal special milk program.

This bill provides that a child is not eligible to receive milk under the program during the school's breakfast or lunch period. The bill also renames the morning milk program the school day milk program.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

15 “(7x) SCHOOL DAY MILK PROGRAM. The treatment of sections 20.255 (2) (cp) and
16 115.343 (title), (1), and (2) (c) of the statutes first applies to aid paid to schools under
17 section 115.343 of the statutes, as affected by this act, in the 2002–03 school year.”.
