Statement of Intent

Fish Lake Water Level Remediation Project Funding

The cause of high water on Fish Lake has been determined to be excessive groundwater recharge. Indications are that the water will continue to rise, resulting in sustained adverse affects on the lake itself and its surrounding ecosystems, as well as public and private property in the area. Pumping water from Fish Lake to the Wisconsin River and maintaining a reasonable water level two feet lower than the current level would provide numerous public interest benefits for the areas surrounding each of the three lakes. Improved water quality and lower lake levels would help restore normal fish and aquatic vegetation environments, as well as lost wildlife habitat and shoreline and non-point buffer zones. Lower lake levels would also alleviate the need for ongoing repair to town road, eroded by high water, and stop the continuous damage to homes and property located along the lake.

Require DNR to provide \$200,000 SEG from the Lake Management Grant Program (DNR - Water Quality) for the water quality and lake level improvements of Fish, Crystal and Mud Lakes in NW Dane County (found in the 47th Assembly District and the 16th Senate District) for installation of a water pump and drainpipe from Fish Lake to the Wisconsin River.

Fiscal Impact

Estimated costs for the pumping and water level lowering remediation effort are in the \$350,000 range. Funding is proposed to come from the \$200,000 SEG DNR Premier Lakes Program grant, as well as grants from both Dane and Columbia County, and general funding from the townships of Roxbury and West Point.


