



(a) more than one grant per fiscal year to an applicant on behalf of an area under par. (c) and may not or award grants to the applicant for more than 2 fiscal years. Grants awarded to an applicant under par. (c) may not exceed \$25,000 in the first fiscal year, or \$15,000 in the 2nd fiscal year, in which the applicant receives a grant under par. (c).

Grant proceeds must be used to promote historic and prehistoric attractions in the area, and may be used for such purposes as interpretive or directional signs, website development, advertising, and public relations. The department may award grants under this subsection to a nonprofit organization that received grants under sub. (2m) (c) as an applicant on behalf of an area of the state selected under sub. (2m) (a).".
