Agency Natural Resources

Summary This amendment would transfer \$100,000 from the State Forestry account to the Urban Forestry Grant Program. In addition, the \$100,000 would be earmarked for use by local units of government in Winnebago and Outagamie Counties for the purchase of trees.

Fiscal Impact Since this amendment transfers dollars already appropriated, no additional state revenues will be needed.

B. Local Governmental Unit Negotiation and Cost-Recovery Process for Contaminated Property

1. Expand the applicability of the negotiation and cost-recovery process found in s. 292.35 (Local governmental unit negotiation and cost recovery) so that it may be used by a local governmental unit that does not own a contaminated property.
2. To qualify under this proposal, the local governmental unit must commit itself to paying more than 50 percent of the investigation and remedial action costs, less any financial assistance received, for the contaminated property.
3. Limit this expansion to sites partially owned by a local unit of government, so long as the unit agrees to pay more than 50 percent of the costs.

C. Sustainable Urban Development Zone Program

Amend Joint Finance action to read:

Recreate a competitive sustainable urban development zone grant program. Provide \$525,000 environmental fund SEG in 2001-02 in a biennial appropriation. Specify that the state funds may be used to investigate environmental contamination and for environmental remediation of brownfields properties in municipalities. Earmark \$150,000 to the City of Platteville and \$250,000 to the City of Fond du Lac. Direct DNR to accept applications from municipalities for the remaining funds and to consult with DOA and Commerce in administering the program.

9. Forestry

A. Urban Forestry Grant Program

Amend the Joint Finance action relating to earmarked funds for tree planting to read:

Provide \$45,000 annually of the \$529,900 available from the urban forestry grant program for tree planting demonstration projects in Milwaukee, Racine and Waupaca. Specify that \$15,000 annually in the 2001-03 biennium only be provided to Greening Milwaukee, a non-profit organization promoting urban forestry in Milwaukee. In addition, earmark \$15,000 annually in the 2001-03 biennium only to the City of Racine and \$15,000 annually in the 2001-03 biennium for the city of Waupaca.

C. Forester to the Willow Flowage Forest

Require the Department of Natural Resources to assign 1.0 FTE Forester to the Willow Flowage Forest stationed out of Lake Tomahawk for the specific purpose of managing the Willow Flowage Forest using sound forest management techniques provided the following requirements are complied with (a) the assigned forester have received a bachelor's or higher degree from a school of forestry with a curriculum accredited by the society of American Foresters in the management of forest resources; (b) the assigned forester make him/herself available to the public, counties and private landowners in the Willow Flowage Forest area to advise how techniques used to manage the Willow Flowage Forest can be used elsewhere to promote sound forest management throughout the State of Wisconsin.

Require the chief state forester designated by the Secretary of Natural Resources shall have received a bachelor's or higher degree from a school of forestry with a curriculum accredited by the society of American Foresters in the management of forest resources to be applied to appointments made subsequent to the effective date of this biennial budget.
