Begin the firearm deer hunting season on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 16 consecutive days.

Restore the base \$100,000 SEG funding from the fish and wildlife account to fund the deer management education, public outreach and vital white tail deer research.

Adopt the Governor's recommendation to provide \$166,000 in 2001-02 and \$157,900 in 2002-03 from the fish and wildlife account for implementation of Deer 2000 recommendations.

B. Signage of DNR fishing easements

Agency affected: DNR

Move to require at least one sign on each DNR easement for fishing access that informs the public that fishing is allowed.

Fiscal impact: DNR already produces fishing access signs so no new expenses are anticipated.

C. Direct Line Authority for Chief Warden

Allow for direct line authority for chief warden and require DNR to redefine the job description of all conservation warden supervisors to specify that 50% of each position's hours be devoted to field enforcement activities and 50% to supervisory activities. Further, require DNR to assign each conservation warden supervisor to a specific geographical area, with priority given to those areas with the greatest demand for enforcement activity.

TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page 448, line 14: after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 1038am. 23.10 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

4 23.10 (1m) The department shall designate a conservation warden as the chief
5 warden. The chief warden shall have the duty to direct, supervise, and control
6 conservation wardens in the performance of their duties under sub. (1) and s. 29.921.

7 The department shall require that each conservation warden designated as a
8 supervisor devote one-half of his or her time to supervisory activities and one-half
9 of his or her time to enforcement activities. If the department divides the state into
10 geographical units for the purpose of managing its functions, the department shall

1 assign each conservation warden designated as a supervisor to a geographical unit.
2 The department shall ensure that those assignments are made in such a manner as
3 to address the specific enforcement needs of each geographical unit.”.
