E. State Parks

Agency affected: DNR

Require that any state park that receives funds from the Fish and Wildlife Account in the last ten years must be open to hunting and fishing to the maximum extent possible, including as necessary closure to non-hunting purposes for the 9-day gun season

Fiscal impact: \$0

F. Commercial Fishing Licenses and Limits

Move to create a suspended license for commercial fisherman on the Bay of Green Bay to allow license holder to retain their licenses for seven years without fishing. Additionally, wave the minimum catch requirement for seven years.

G. Free Hunter Safety Education Courses
