E. State Parks

Agency affected: DNR

Require that any state park that receives funds from the Fish and Wildlife Account in the last ten years must be open to hunting and fishing to the maximum extent possible, including as necessary closure to non-hunting purposes for the 9-day gun season

Fiscal impact: \$0

Location/Status: New motion

F. Commercial Fishing Licenses and Limits

Move to create a suspended license for commercial fisherman on the Bay of Green Bay to allow license holder to retain their licenses for seven years without fishing. Additionally, wave the minimum catch requirement for seven years.

Affected agency: DNR

Location/Status: New motion (Lasee, F.)

Fiscal impact: Fees generated from the sale of commercial fishing licenses could be reduced slightly.

G. Free Hunter Safety Education Courses

Move to provide that the DNR shall fund hunter safety education courses from the fish and wildlife account of the conservation fund and that the courses shall be free to students.

Location/Status: New motion (Johnsrud)

Fiscal impact: \$171,200/year SEG; loss of \$102,600 SEG Revenue

H. Hunting Easements in a Village

Require the DNR to partially nullify hunting easements in Crawford County in the village of Wauzeka on portions of those eased lands adjacent to school owned properties.

Affected agency: DNR

Fiscal Impact: None

Location/Status: Adopt ARC Amendment #305 (Johnsrud)

I. Kickapoo Valley Reserve Visitor Center

Motion to provide \$2,370,000 in general obligation bonds to be repaid from the forestry account for the construction of a visitor center and administration building at the Kickapoo Valley Reserve.

Location/Status: LFB paper 263, alternative 3

Fiscal effect: \$94,500 SEG (Johnsrud)

J. Herd Control Deer Hunting Seasons

Create a permanent, statewide, antlerless only firearm deer hunting season beginning on Thursday nearest October 22 and continuing for four days. Make it illegal for DNR to authorize antlerless only firearm deer seasons in December.

Location/status: New motion (Johnsrud)

Fiscal impact: None since similar seasons already exist.

K. Venison Donation Programs

Move to clarify that DNR's venison donation program is a statewide program and not limited to counties with special herd control deer seasons.

Location/status: LFB paper 649

Fiscal impact: DNR would be able to use existing funds statewide instead of only in deer management units with special herd control seasons.

L. Deer Management

Adopt the Governor's provision.

Affected agency: DNR

Location/Status: [Comparative summary of Governor and Joint Finance Committee Budget Recommendations, Natural Resources—Fish, Wildlife and Recreation, page 521, item #10]

11. Dam Projects

A. Prairie River Restoration

Require the Department of Natural Resources to appropriate \$493,500 SEG from the Water Resources fund in the conservation fund for the specific purpose of restoring exposed lakebed watershed land on the Prairie River where the Ward Paper Mill Dam previously operated.

Agency affected: DNR

Fiscal Impact: \$493,500 SEG

Location/Status: Adopt ARC Amendment #228 (Friske)

B. Public Law 566 Structures

2. Require DNR to earmark \$2,370,000 from stewardship 2000 program bonding for the construction of a visitor center and administration building at the Kickapoo Valley Reserve. Allow DNR to determine from which stewardship categories funding would be allocated.

3. Provide forestry account supported bonding of \$2,370,000 and create a sum sufficient debt retirement appropriation under the Department of Tourism for the construction of a visitor center and administration building at the Kickapoo Valley Reserve. Estimate debt service of \$94,500 SEG in 2002-03.
