 The Commerce Department is the primary state agency for economic development. The Kettl Commission on State-Local Partnerships for the 21st Century noted that many of the state's most important economic development strategies involve tax incentives and regulatory policy. The Commission recommended regular reviews of our regulatory and tax codes to make sure they were coordinated through the state's economic strategy.

Motion:

Require the Commerce Department to report to the appropriate standing committees of the legislature and the Joint Finance Committee by July 1, 2002 on a plan to create an Office of Economic Strategy that would be responsible for coordination of all state government efforts on economic development.

- a) Heritage Tourism Program (at the request of Rep's. Wade and Skindrud)
 (Incorporates) Request #34 & #131 (FUNDING SOURCE DIFFERENT)
 The Heritage Tourism Grant program provides funding to increases visits to attractions, sites and area that are perceived to have a historic or cultural value and interest, and to preserve these historically and culturally significant sits. Each biennium, the Department is authorizes to select, upon application, two additional areas of the state to participate in heritage tourism. The Joint Finance Committee eliminated the State Heritage Tourism Program but specified that Heritage Tourism areas may seek funding through the Department's Joint Effort Marketing (JEM) grant program.

Motion:

Restore Governor's recommendation.
 Reallocate \$200,000 PR-tribal gaming revenues from the Tourism Marketing Appropriation for Milwaukee Public Museum and \$100,000 from the Badger State Games to the Heritage Tourism Program.
