**Agency** Natural Resources

**Summary** Delete the action of the Joint Finance Committee on Motion #1006, providing \$100,000 SEG annually from GPR to the all-terrain vehicle account of the conservation fund for operations and maintenance of state trails.

Instead convert \$205,900 in 2001-02 and \$205,900 in 2002-03 and 4.0 conservation warden positions from GPR to the ATV account of the conservation fund for increased ATV enforcement and education efforts.

Also, require the Department of Natural Resources to submit an annual reporting to the Joint Legislative Audit Committee of how FTE warden positions have benefited increased ATV enforcement and education efforts.

**Fiscal Impact** Delete \$200,000 SEG found in motion #1006. — *repeal + take out of Schedule 20370(1)(mr)*
