**Agency** Public Instruction

**Summary** The Wisconsin Book Festival would highlight state authors, encourage young authors, increase literacy efforts, and promote the joys of reading. Similar festivals have been held in several other states around the country and attract broad support and involvement from academia, the public sector, private businesses and individuals.

First Lady Laura Bush established the Texas Book Festival, and since it's inception 5 years ago, more than \$1 million in proceeds from that festival have been awarded to Texas public libraries.

This amendment would require the DPI to provide a \$50,000 grant from the Alternative Education Grants Program to the Wisconsin Humanities Council to organize and plan the Wisconsin Book Festival.

**Fiscal Impact** None. The motion earmarks \$50,000 of the \$5 million GPR categorical aid set aside for alternative education grants.
