Similar festivals have been held in several other states around the country and attract broad support and involvement from academia, the public sector, private businesses and individuals.

First Lady Laura Bush established the Texas Book Festival, and since it's inception 5 years ago, more than \$1 million in proceeds from that festival have been awarded to Texas public libraries.

This amendment would require the DPI to provide a \$50,000 grant from the Alternative Education Grants Program to the Wisconsin Humanities Council to organize and plan the Wisconsin Book Festival.
