Summary

Base funding of \$8,373,600 GPR is appropriated for state tuition payments and certain full-time open enrollment transfer payments.

State tuition payments. The state reimburses the cost of educating children who live in properties for which there is no parental property tax base support. Specifically, school districts and county children with disabilities education boards (CCDEBs) are eligible for tuition payments for the following: a. Children in children's homes (nonprofit organizations licensed by the Department of Health and Family Services) who have usually been placed in the home by the state or by county social services departments.

b. Children whose parents are employed at, and reside on the grounds of, a state or federal military camp, federal veteran hospital or state charitable or penal institution. c. Children who live in foster or group homes if the home is outside the district in which the pupil's parent or guardian resides and is exempt from the property tax.

The state payment is calculated on the basis of the school district's average daily cost per pupil and the number of school days the child is enrolled in school.
