moneys for a prohibited purpose must reimburse the TEACH board and is ineligible for additional educational telecommunication access grants.

Finally, the bill requires the TEACH board to award educational telecommunications access grants to private, sectarian schools that would have received the grants were it not for the decision in *Freedom from Religion Foundation, Inc.*

7 **SECTION 1440mb.** 44.73 (6) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

8 44.73 (6) (e) If a private school uses grant moneys awarded under this
9 subsection for any purpose prohibited under par. (c), the private school shall
10 reimburse the board in an amount equal to the grant moneys expended for the
11 prohibited purpose. A private school that uses grant moneys for a prohibited purpose
12 is ineligible for additional grants under this subsection.”.

13 **3.** Page 1355, line 14: after that line insert:

14 “(6xf) GRANTS FOR SECTARIAN SCHOOLS. No later than June 30, 2002, the
15 technology for educational achievement in Wisconsin board shall award grants
16 under section 44.73 (6) of the statutes, as affected by this act, to private schools that
17 would have received such grants during the 1999–2000 and 2000–01 fiscal years had
18 the injunction in *Freedom from Religion Foundation v. Bugher*, No. 98–C–767–S
19 (United States District Court, Western District of Wisconsin), not been issued.”.
