Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law permits a school board to provide instruction in human sexuality. reproduction family planning, human immunodeficiency virus and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome, prenatal development, childbirth, adoption, available prenatal and postnatal support, and male responsibility. This bill allows a school board to/provide instruction in both male and female responsibility. The bill also provides that if a school board offers instruction in any of these subjects relating to human sexuality, it must also offer instruction in marriage and parental responsibility.
