The substitute amendment to the budget amends ss. 25.29 (3) and 29.037 to limit the use of license fees to the exercise of the department's responsibilities that are specific to fish and wildlife management. This language is included in the budget to bring Wisconsin into compliance with federal law. This amendment, if drafted as requested, would broaden the purposes for which license fees may be used to any conservation purpose. If the purposes are broadened to include conservation purposes other than fish and wildlife management, the provisions will render Wisconsin out of compliance, and Wisconsin will lose funding under the Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act and the Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Restoration Act. I, therefore, did not draft this

en to broaden the scope of the use of the moneys.
