Summary DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION (DOA) RESPONSIBILITIES

-- Establish that the DOA is responsible for developing and administering the grant program created by this amendment.

ELIGIBLE SCHOOL DISTRICTS

-- Establish that any school district is eligible to receive an energy grant.

-- Require as a condition of eligibility that the annual meeting in a common school district, or the school board in a unified school district or in a school district operating under ch. 119 adopts a resolution requesting the grant and submits the resolution to DOA under the procedures specified by DOA. (This requirement is based upon a similar requirement in the TEACH educational technology block grant program.)

GRANT AMOUNT

-- Specify that the amount of the grant awarded to an eligible school district shall be the portion of the amount appropriated for the energy grants that is in proportion to:

-- The school district's expenses for natural gas and other gaseous fuels and heating oil used for heating and other uses of natural gas and other gaseous fuels in 2000-01 compared to the statewide total for eligible districts for these expenses, based on data submitted to DPI in annual school district reports under s. 120.18, Stats.

GRANT DISTRIBUTION

-- Establish that the grants must be disbursed by the DOA by December 1, 2001 or three months after the effective date of the grant program, whichever is later.

USES OF GRANT AWARDS

-- Establish that moneys received by a school district in the grant may be used for any expense other than salary or benefits of any school district employee.

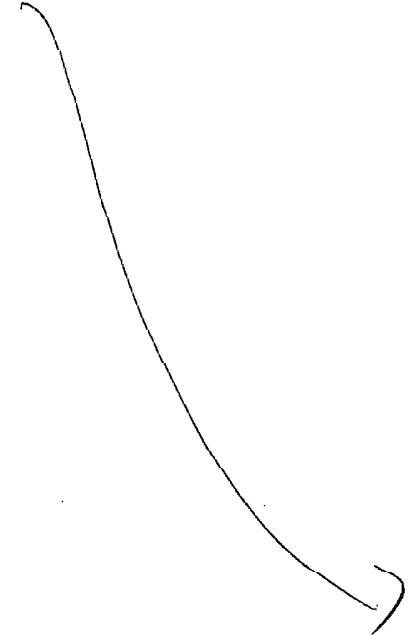

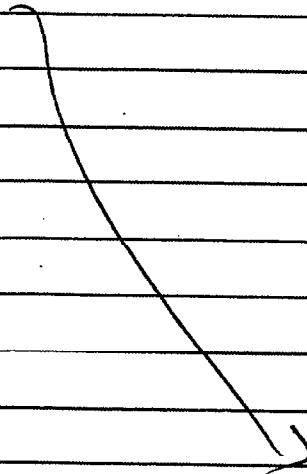

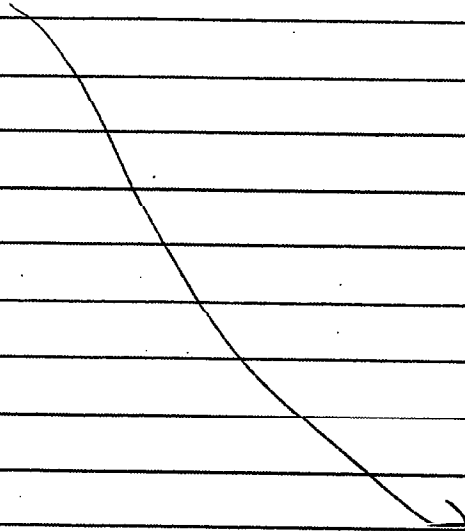
