Summary Requires DHFS to allocate \$299,000 GPR and \$793,500 FED in 2001-02 and \$231,000 GPR and \$140,200 FED in 2002-03 from the MA administration appropriations for development and support of the Wisconsin immunization registry (WIR) registry. Expand the purposes for which expenditures can be made from this appropriation to include the development and support of the registry.

The release of these funds will be subject to a s.16.505/16.515 request to the Joint Finance Committee that will include a Memorandum of Understanding between the Department and Marshfield Clinic as to funding for those aspects of the RECIN system, supporting immunization record collection outside of the Mashfield Clinic system that result in a savings to the WIR system that would otherwise be borne by the State. Those funds will come from TANF funds previously allocated by the legislature for use in the support of immunization in Wisconsin.

Fiscal Impact Currently, a s.16.505/16.515 request from the Department of Health and Family Services is pending before the JFC under the 14-day passive review process. The s.16.505/16.515 request provides additional PR positions and budget authority for Winnebago and Mendota Mental Health Institutes. The additional staff are required to meet the needs of the increased populations that have occurred at both Mental Health Institutes in FY01. The 14-day review process ends on June 20. Provided the s.16.505/16.515 request is approved, the Mental Health Institute split, which allocates administrative costs between PR- and GPR-funded activities, would be revised. The revised Institute split will decrease GPR \$265,100 each year and increase PR \$265,100 each year, thereby generating \$530,000 GPR savings in the biennium. The \$530,000 GPR savings from the revised Mental Health Institute split will serve as an offset to the \$530,000 GPR provided in this motion to fund the WIR. As a result, this motion is cost-neutral.

I just got off the phone with Lippert who is a cosponsor on the immunization registry. So I wanted to confirm and clarify what I was trying to say before.

They want to provide \$299,000 GPR in 02 and \$231,000 GPR in 03 in the JFC approp to be released under 14 day passive review. The federal funding (\$793,500 in 02 and \$140,200 in 03) should be appropriated under the MA approp

In order for the funds to be released the Marshfield Clinic on behalf of the Regional Early Childhood Immunization Network (RECIN) and DHFS would have to submit an MOU that would include funding for those aspects of the RECIN system that would support immunization collection outside of the RECIN system, and result in savings for the WIR system under DHFS. It is this funding that would come from the \$1,000,000 annually in TANF funds that are allocated to the immunization program.

The request shall include a memorandum of understanding between the Department and the Marshfield Clinic, on behalf of the Regional Early Childhood Immunization Network, that specifies the amount of funding to be allocated under section 49.175 (1)(ze) 9 to support immunization data collection by the Regional Early Childhood Immunization Network, outside of the area currently served by the network, that would result in savings to the registry administered by the Department or to the state.
