

Trims excess metal specified for use in connection with or incidental to gutters and downspouts, roof curbs, louvers, ridges, copings, hips, valleys, roof flanges, flashings, wall cap, mansards, skylights, columns and any and all other shapes and forms of corrugated or flat metal work specified for use for decorative or display purposes or as trim on the exterior of buildings or structures using power or hand tools.
