Proposal:

Allow public project wage rates and hours to be included in the yearly Prevailing Wage survey when the wages paid on a public project exceed the prevailing wage set for the project. *Under current law, only wages and hours on private projects, except for highway work, can be included in the prevailing wage calculation.*
