

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 76,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55**

June 29, 2001 – Offered by Representatives J. LEHMAN and TURNER.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:  
2           **1.** Page 296, line 24: after that line insert:  
3           “**SECTION 438m.** 20.143 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4           20.143 **(1)** (c) *Wisconsin development fund; grants, loans, reimbursements and*  
5           *assistance.* Biennially, the amounts in the schedule for grants under ss. 560.145,  
6           560.16, 560.175<sub>1</sub> and 560.26; for grants and loans under ss. 560.62, 560.63<sub>1</sub> and  
7           560.66; for loans under s. 560.147; for reimbursements under s. 560.167; for  
8           providing assistance under s. 560.06; for the costs specified in s. 560.607; for the loan  
9           under 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, section 9110 (4); ~~and~~ for the grants under 1995  
10          Wisconsin Act 27, section 9116 (7gg), 1995 Wisconsin Act 119, section 2 (1), 1997  
11          Wisconsin Act 27, section 9110 (6g), and 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, section 9110 (5); and  
12          for providing up to \$100,000 annually for the continued development of a

1 manufacturing and advanced technology training center in Racine. Of the amounts  
2 in the schedule, \$50,000 shall be allocated in each of fiscal years 1997–98 and  
3 1998–99 for providing the assistance under s. 560.06 (1). Notwithstanding s.  
4 560.607, of the amounts in the schedule, \$125,000 shall be allocated in each of 4  
5 consecutive fiscal years, beginning with fiscal year 1998–99, for grants and loans  
6 under s. 560.62 (1) (a).”.
