

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 122,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55**

June 29, 2001 – Offered by Representative HUBLER.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2           **1.** Page 926, line 2: after that line insert:

3           “**SECTION 2767h.** 121.08 (4) (a) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

4           121.08 **(4)** (a) 2. Divide the sum under subd. 1. by the total amount of state aid  
5           that all school districts are eligible to be paid from the appropriation under s. 20.255  
6           (2) (ac), ~~calculated as if the reduction under par. (c) had not occurred.~~

7           **SECTION 2767hj.** 121.08 (4) (a) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

8           121.08 **(4)** (a) 3. Multiply the amount of state aid that the school district is  
9           eligible to be paid from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (ac), ~~calculated as if the~~  
10          ~~reduction under par. (c) had not occurred,~~ by the quotient under subd. 2.

11          **SECTION 2767j.** 121.08 (4) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

**121.08 (4) (b)** The amount of state aid that the school district operating under ch. 119 is eligible to be paid from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (ac) shall also be reduced by 50% of the amounts paid under s. 119.23 (4) and (4m) in the current school year.

**SECTION 2767k.** 121.08 (4) (c) of the statutes is repealed.

**SECTION 2767L.** 121.08 (4) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

121.08 (4) (d) The state superintendent shall ensure that aid paid to school districts other than the school district operating under ch. 119 is neither reduced nor increased as a result of the reduction in aid under par. (b) and that the total amount of aid reduction under pars. (a) to (c) and (b) lapses to the general fund.”.

**2.** Page 1402, line 13: after that line insert:

“(14m) MILWAUKEE PARENTAL CHOICE PROGRAM. The treatment of section 121.08 (4) (a) 2. and 3., (b), (c), and (d) of the statutes first applies to state aid paid in the school year beginning after the effective date of this subsection.”.
