Require DATCP and the Department of Commerce to review scientific evidence to determine whether there is a substantial likelihood that wood treated with copper, chromium and arsenic is harmful to the environment or to human health. Require the Departments to report the results of their review to the chief clerk of each house of the Legislature by June 30, 2002. Further, require the Departments to promulgate rules that phase in restrictions on the use of wood treated with copper, chromium and arsenic, if the Departments determine that such wood is harmful to human health or the environment. However, do not allow the Departments to prohibit the use of wood treated with copper, chromium and arsenic for a purpose unless there is a less harmful substitute wood preservative that may be used for that purpose. Set forfeitures at \$500 for each violation of any resulting rules promulgated by DATCP and Commerce.

Require DATCP and Commerce to submit, to the Joint Committee on Finance by the fourth quarterly meeting in 2001 under s. 13.10, a comprehensive plan to recommend how to keep wood treated with arsenic, inorganic arsenic or an arsenic copper combination such as chromated copper arsenate wood preservative fungicide from being used, if there is a less harmful substitute wood preservative that may be used, either at K-12 schools or in municipal parks in: (a) picnic tables; (b) park benches; or (c) children's playground equipment.
