Senate: Require DHFS to allocate \$299,000 GPR and \$793,500 FED in 2001-02 and \$527,400 GPR and \$140,200 FED in 2002-03 from amounts budgeted for contracted services relating to the administration of the MA program to develop and maintain the Wisconsin immunization registry. Expand the purposes for which expenditures could be made from the GPR MA administration appropriation to include the development and support of the registry. The registry is an automated, web-based system to centralize record keeping of immunization records for all Wisconsin children. The funding would be used to implement and support the system statewide.
