#### 6. DRIVER RECORD ABSTRACT FEES

Senate: No change to Joint Finance.

Assembly: Modify a provision of the Joint Committee on Finance's substitute amendment that would increase the fees for driver record abstracts by \$2 (from \$3 to \$5 in most cases), effective on the first day of the sixth month beginning after the effective date of the bill

Chg. to JFC SEG-REV - \$3,901,700

and then by an additional \$0.20, effective on July 1, 2002, to instead increase the fees by only \$1 (from \$3 to \$4 in most cases), effective on the first day of the sixth month beginning after the effective date of the bill, with no further increase on July 1, 2002. #### 7. GENERAL TRANSPORTATION AID

The plan shall require that the amount of any proposed reductions from program revenue, program revenue-service, or segregated fund revenue-service appropriations lapse to the transportation fund. If the cochairpersons of the committee do not notify the department of transportation that the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of reviewing the proposed plan within 14 working days after the date of the submittal, the department of transportation may implement the plan. If, within 14 days after the date of the submittal, the cochairpersons of the committee notify the department of transportation that the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of
reviewing the proposed plan, the department of transportation may not implement
the plan until it is approved by the committee, as submitted or as modified.".
