transportation fund, first applying to property tax assessments as of January 1, 2002. Require DOR to make a separate valuation of each repair facility for the purposes of calculating the terminal tax payment. Increase funding by \$100,000 SEG in 2002-03 to reflect this change.

6. DRIVER RECORD ABSTRACT FEES

Senate: No change to Joint Finance.

Assembly: Modify a provision of the Joint Committee on Finance's substitute amendment that would increase the fees for driver record abstracts by \$2 (from \$3 to \$5 in most cases), effective on the first day of the sixth month beginning after the effective date of the bill and then by an additional \$0.20, effective on July 1, 2002, to instead increase the fees by only \$1 (from \$3 to \$4 in most cases), effective on the first day of the sixth month beginning after the effective date of the bill, with no further increase on July 1, 2002. Reduce estimated transportation fund revenue by \$1,141,600 in 2001-02 and \$2,760,100 in 2002-03.

7. GENERAL TRANSPORTATION AID

Senate: Increase funding by \$865,900 in 2002-03 for counties and \$2,723,900 in 2002-03 for municipalities to provide an increase in general transportation aid of 3% in 2002 and 4% in 2003. Set the calendar year distributions at \$86,581,300 for 2002 and \$90,044,600 for 2003 and thereafter for counties and \$272,395,300 for 2002 and \$283,291,100 for 2003 and thereafter for municipalities. Establish the mileage aid rate at \$1,704 for calendar year 2001, \$1,755 for calendar year 2002 and \$1,825 for calendar year 2003 and thereafter. Suspend the general transportation aid formula for calendar years 2002 and 2003 and provide each county and municipality with a percentage increase in aid equal to 3% in 2002 and 4% in 2003.

8. CITY OF LA CROSSE -- PAYMENT OF CLAIM

Senate: Direct DOT to make a payment from the sum sufficient corrections of transportation aid payments appropriation for a claim against the state made by the City of La Crosse. Specify that the \$8,420.92 payment would be partial reimbursement for a penalty that was assessed against the City for tardy filing of its annual financial report with the state for 1999. Specify that the acceptance of the payment by the City would release the state and its officers, employees and agents from any further liability relating to deduction of penalties from general transportation aids payable to the City for calendar year 2000. Amend the appropriation from the effective date of the bill through January 1, 2003, to allow for the

9 transportation to implement 1999 Wisconsin Act 11, section 27 (1) (b) 1., for the
10 payment of contributions under the Wisconsin retirement system, the department
11 of transportation shall submit a plan to the joint committee on finance for allocating
12 reductions of \$3,530,800 in fiscal year 2001–02 among program revenue, program
13 revenue–service, segregated fund revenue, and segregated fund revenue–service
14 appropriations, as defined in section 20.001 (2) (b), (c), (d), and (da) of the statutes,
15 less any amount lapsed in fiscal year 2000–01 as a result of any credits by the
16 department of employee trust funds to the department of transportation’s
17 appropriations to implement such act. The plan shall require that the amount of any
18 proposed reductions from program revenue, program revenue–service, or segregated
19 fund revenue–service appropriations lapse to the transportation fund. If the
20 cochairpersons of the committee do not notify the department of transportation that
21 the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of reviewing the proposed
22 plan within 14 working days after the date of the submittal, the department of
23 transportation may implement the plan. If, within 14 days after the date of the
24 submittal, the cochairpersons of the committee notify the department of
