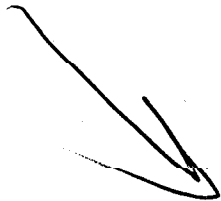

3 "SECTION 2026nz. 66.0903 (3) (am) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 66.0903 (3) (am) A local governmental unit, before making a contract by direct  
5 negotiation or soliciting bids on a contract, for the erection, construction, remodeling,  
6 repairing or demolition of any project of public works, including a highway, street or  
7 bridge construction project, shall apply to the department to determine the  
8 prevailing wage rate for each trade or occupation required in the work contemplated.

9 The department shall conduct investigations and hold public hearings as necessary

1 to define the trades or occupations that are commonly employed on projects that are  
 2 subject to this section and to inform itself as to the prevailing wage rates in all areas  
 3 of the state for those trades or occupations, in order to determine the prevailing wage  
 4 rate for each trade or occupation. In defining those trades or occupations, the  
 5 department shall define metal building assembler as a separate trade or occupation  
 6 for purposes of determining the prevailing wage rates for that trade or occupation  
 7 and shall include among the typical duties of that trade or occupation reroofing and  
 8 assembling components for use in construction canopies, reroofs, and mezzanines.

9 The department shall issue its determination within 30 days after receiving the  
 10 request and shall file the determination with the requesting local governmental  
 11 unit.”

12 **2.** Page 904, line 24: after that line insert:

13 **“SECTION 2558h. 103.49 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:**

14 103.49 (3) (a) Before bids are asked for any work to which this section applies,  
 15 the state agency having the authority to prescribe the specifications shall apply to  
 16 the department to determine the prevailing wage rate for each trade or occupation  
 17 required in the work under contemplation in the area in which the work is to be done.  
 18 The department shall conduct investigations and hold public hearings as necessary  
 19 to define the trades or occupations that are commonly employed on projects that are  
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*repairing existing prefabricated, prepackaged metal buildings and  
 construction of prefabricated, prepackaged metal additions to  
 existing prefabricated, prepackaged metal buildings*



1 and shall include among the typical duties of that trade or occupation reroofing and  
2 assembling components for use in constructing canopies, reroofs, and mezzanines.

3 The department shall issue its determination within 30 days after receiving the  
4 request and shall file the determination with the requesting state agency. For the  
5 information of the employees working on the project, the prevailing wage rates  
6 determined by the department, the prevailing hours of labor and the provisions of  
7 subs. (2) and (6m) shall be kept posted by the state agency in at least one conspicuous  
8 and easily accessible place on the site of the project.”.

10 “(3z) PREVAILING WAGE RATES; JOB CLASSIFICATIONS. The treatment of sections  
11 66.0903 (3) (am) and 103.49 (3) (a) of the statutes takes effect on January 1, 2002,  
12 or on the day after publication, whichever is later.”.
