I've reviewed budget draft 2052/1 and am thinking about the July 1, 2003 date. The Committee's intent is to ensure that funding would not be transferred in the 2001-03 biennium, but I believe that DHFS will not have all of the data for the previous fiscal year on July 1 so that it would not be able to submit the required information on July 1, 2003. I think the date should be changed to October 1, 2003 so that DHFS will have sufficient time to review complete nursing home utilization data in the previous fiscal year to propose a transfer in the 2003-4 fiscal year.

Do you think the draft would require DHFS to submit the report on July 1, 2003? If so, I would recommend that the date be changed to October 1, 2003. Thank-you. Charlie Morgan


