19. CONSERVATION WARDEN FUNDING *E-mail*

Senate: No change to Joint Finance.

Assembly: Delete \$357,900 GPR annually and provide an equivalent amount of fish and wildlife account SEG funding to transfer five GPR-supported conservation warden positions to fish and wildlife SEG. Further, delete \$205,900 GPR annually and provide an equivalent amount of all-terrain vehicle account SEG funding to transfer four GPR-supported conservation warden positions to all-terrain vehicle SEG. In addition, require DNR to submit a report to the Joint Legislative Audit Committee no later than August 15th of each year (beginning in 2002) detailing how the increase in ATV-related warden enforcement activity has benefited DNR's efforts to enforce laws related to ATV activity and to educate the public on these laws.

20. CHIEF WARDEN AUTHORITY AND SUPERVISORS

Senate: No change to Joint Finance.

Assembly: Require DNR to designate a conservation warden as the chief warden. This chief warden would have the responsibility of directing, supervising, and controlling other DNR conservation wardens. Further, specify that any conservation warden that is designated as a supervisor would be required to spend half of his or her time performing field enforcement activities, and half performing supervisory activities.

Senate: Provide \$663,100 in 2001-02 and \$684,300 in 2002-03 in 2002-03 and 6.0 positions from the fish and wildlife account for fisheries management staffing. Funding would provide 3.0 fisheries biologists and 3.0 fisheries technicians. In addition, provide \$368,900 in 2001-02 and \$388,400 in 2002-03 and 6.0 positions from the fish and wildlife account for wildlife management staffing. Funding would provide 1.0 wildlife biologist and 5.0 wildlife technicians.

This increase would reflect LTE costs incurred, and a 15% increase in the average hourly rate received by the Bureau's LTEs in efforts to improve recruitment and retention.
