(a) During the 2001-03 fiscal biennium, the department of natural resources may submit to the joint committee on finance a proposal concerning the continued development of a system to provide computer accessible water resource management information.

(b) If the cochairpersons of the committee do not notify the department within 14 working days after the date of any submittal under paragraph (a) that the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of reviewing the proposal, the appropriation under section 20.370 (4) (aq) of the statutes, as affected by this act, is supplemented by \$100,000 for fiscal year 2002-03, from the appropriation account under section 20.865 (4) (u) of the statutes, and the appropriation under section 20.370 (4) (ax) of the statutes, as created by this act, is supplemented by \$100,000 for fiscal year 2002-03, from the appropriation account under section 20.865 (4) (u) of the statutes, for the purpose of implementing the proposal. If, within 14 working days after the date of the submittal under paragraph (a), the cochairpersons of the committee notify the department that the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of reviewing the proposal and if the committee approves the proposal, the committee may, from the appropriation under section 20.865 (4) (u) of the statutes, supplement the appropriation under section 20.370 (4) (aq) of the statutes, as affected by this act, by an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for fiscal year 2002-03 and may supplement the appropriation under section 20.370 (4) (ax) of the statutes, as
