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


52. STRUCTURAL GRANT PROGRAM FOR RURAL FIRE DEPARTMENTS

RSM Senate: No change to Joint Finance.

Assembly: Authorize DNR to create a grant program that would provide grants to fire departments that are considered "first responders" in areas with a population below 6,000, and who have entered into mutual aid agreements for structural fire protection with neighboring fire departments. Grants would be awarded for up to 50% of the cost of equipment used to fight structural fires. Eligible grant uses would include all of the following: (a) personal protective equipment (including protective clothing, breathing apparatuses, and personal alert safety systems); (b) communication equipment (including radios, base stations, and pagers); (c) suppression tools (including pumps, hoses, dry hydrants, and tool trailers); (d) supplies related to fire prevention (including posters, handouts, and smoke detectors); and (e) training related to structural fires (including equipment, materials, and structural training towers). Ineligible grant expenditures would include buildings, vehicles, search and rescue or emergency medical equipment, or equipment or materials that would be used exclusively for the suppression of forest fires. Provide ~~\$320,000~~ SEG annually from the forestry account to fund the grant program. In addition, provide ~~\$30,000~~ SEG annually and 1.0 position from the forestry account to administer the grant program.
