ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE RECOGNITION AND SAFE-**RÈTURN PROGRAM**

Senate: Provide \$30,000 annually to DOJ for publicity activities for a program administered by a nongovernmental entity that registers persons with Alzheimer's disease or other related dementias in a

national database and provides the persons identification bracelets which facilitate their safe return to caregivers if they become lost or wander. Create an appropriation in DOJ to receive these funds.

In addition, require the 400 hours of initial law enforcement training to include at least one hour of instruction on recognizing the symptoms of Alzheimer's disease or other related dementias and interacting with and assisting persons who have Alzheimer's disease or other related dementias. Require that at least one bour of the four required hours of annual recertification training for law enforcement officers include the Alzheimer's disease or other related dementias training outlined above. Define "Alzheimer's disease" for purposes of the law enforcement training requirements to mean a degenerative disease of the central nervous system characterized especially by premature senile mental deterioration, and also includes any other irreversible deterioration of intellectual faculties with concomitant emotional disturbance resulting from organic brain disorder.

9. LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING ON DOMESTIC ABUSE


