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

Further, specify that any conservation warden that is designated as a supervisor would be required to spend half of his or her time performing field enforcement activities, and half performing supervisory activities.~~

Senate: Provide \$663,100 in 2001-02 and \$684,300 in 2002-03 in 2002-03 and 6.0 positions from the fish and wildlife account for fisheries management staffing. Funding would provide 3.0 fisheries biologists and 3.0 fisheries technicians. In addition, provide \$368,500 in 2001-02 and \$338,400 in 2002-03 and 6.0 positions from the fish and wildlife account for wildlife management staffing. Funding would provide 1.0 wildlife biologist and 5.0 wildlife technicians.
