

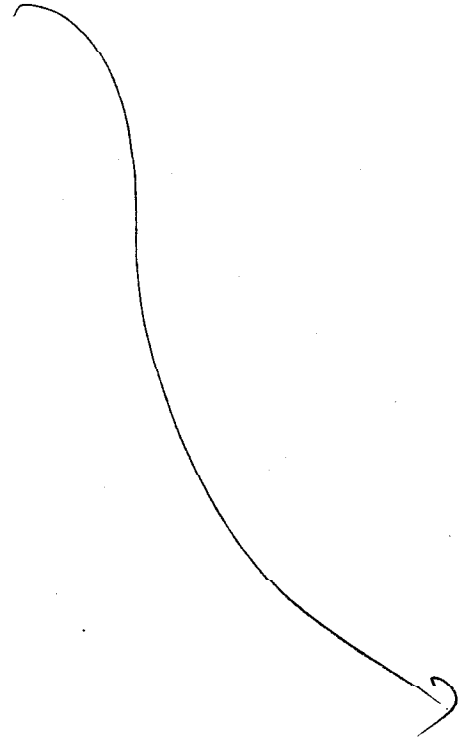

If so, this legislation cannot validly be enacted as part of the state budget bill because the budget bill clearly encompasses more than one subject.

Under *Milwaukee Brewers Baseball Club v. Wisconsin Dept. of Health and Social Services*, 130 Wis. 2d 79, 115 (1986), "a legislative provision which is specific to any person, place or thing is a private or local law within the meaning of art.
