Lonnie,

The conference committee has decided to follow the Assembly's concept of earmarking certain items for which funding is being provided (see LRB 1496). Using the assembly draft as a template (many of the programs are the same, so much of the language would remain the same) make additions and changes as follows:

Ref. to LRB 1496

- Item 1-Delete funding for 2001-02. ✓
- Item 2-Delete funding for 2001-02 and change 02-03 funding to \$1,850,000. ✓
- Item 3-Delete funding for 2001-02 and change 02-03 funding to \$266,000. ✓
- Item 4-Delete funding for 2001-02 and change 02-03 funding to \$1,320,000. ✓
- Item 5-Delete funding for 2001-02 and change 02-03 funding to \$295,000. ✓
- Item 6-for all items, delete reference to approp. 20.285 (1)(im), only refer to funding as specified above and make appropriate changes.

In addition, need new sections and provisions in section 6 (or whatever section it may become) to fund the following:

- ✓ New item for UW-Extension, as per draft 1357 with \$612,000 and 4.0 GPR positions in 02-03 and earmarking provision. → A
- ✓ New item for UW-La Crosse with \$277,900 GPR and 3.0 GPR positions in 2002-03 to fund additional high technology related courses at UW-La Crosse.
- ✓ New item for UW-Oshkosh with \$293,600 GPR and 0.5 GPR positions in 2002-03 to establish an adult student access and advocacy office and for additional faculty and staff to increase the number of students in the master of science in information systems program.
- ✓ New item for UW-Parkside with \$403,000 GPR and 3.33 GPR positions in 2002-03 to fund faculty and staff to expand high tech courses and establish a molecular biology and bio-informatics certificate program.
- ✓ New item for UW-Stevens Point with \$1,204,500 GPR and 26.33 GPR positions in 2002-03 to fund faculty and staff to develop digital science coursework delivered via distance education to non-traditional students.
- ✓ New item for UW-Superior with \$200,200 GPR and 0.33 FTE positions in 2002-03 to fund faculty and staff to implement a transportation and logistics management bachelor's degree program.
- New item for UW-Colleges with \$983,500 GPR and 13.5 GPR positions in 2002-03 to expand technology courses targeted at working adults.
