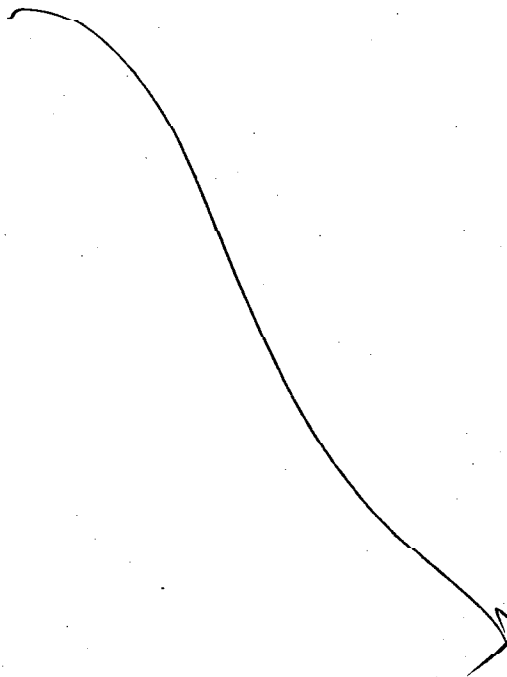

2 **1.** Page 133, line 14: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2001-02 by  
3 \$100,000 to allow the department of public instruction to complete an equating study  
4 to ensure that the high school graduation test meets all federal requirements as a  
5 result of eliminating the 10th grade knowledge and concepts examination.

6 **2.** Page 134, line 8: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2001-02 by  
7 \$3,580,500 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2002-03 by \$3,613,000 to  
8 increase funding for the high school graduation test.

1 ~~3. Page 134, line 8: decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2001-02 by~~  
2 ~~\$460,000 and decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2002-03 by \$460,000 to~~
