Page 133, line 14: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2001–02 by \$100,000 to allow the department of public instruction to complete an equating study to ensure that the high school graduation test meets all federal requirements as a result of eliminating the 10th grade knowledge and concepts examination.
- 2. Page 134, line 8: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2001–02 by \$3,580,500 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2002–03 by \$3,613,000 to increase funding for the high school graduation test.
