Senator Chyala:

Section 16.47 (2), stats., states that neither house may pass any bill containing an appropriation, increasing the cost of state government, or decreasing state revenues by more than \$10,000 annually until both houses pass the executive budget bill, unless the governor or joint committee on finance or, under certain circumstances, the committee on organization of either house recommends that the bill be enacted as an emergency appropriation bill prior to the passage of the executive budget bill.
