6	across a highway or within 50 feet of the center of a roadway.	
7	SECTION 2. 167.31 (4) (g) of the statutes is created to read:	
8	167.31 (4) (g) A person who is fishing with a bow and arrow may shoot an arrow	
9	from a bow within 50 feet of the center of a roadway if the person does not shoot the	
10	arrow from the roadway or across a highway.
