April 11, 2001 – Introduced by Senators RISSER, ROESSLER and M. MEYER, cosponsored by Representatives HOVEN, VRAKAS and PLALE, by request of Governor Scott McCallum. Referred to Committee on Universities, Housing, and Government Operations.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 20.866 (2) (y) of the statutes; **relating to:** state purchase of
2 a Justice Center building and granting bonding authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases the authorized program revenue supported borrowing authority of the state by \$42,600,000 for the 1999–2001 fiscal biennium for the purpose of purchasing a Justice Center building.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 20.866 (2) (y) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 20.866 (2) (y) *Building commission; housing state departments and agencies.*
5 From the capital improvement fund, a sum sufficient to the building commission for
6 the purpose of housing state departments and agencies. The state may contract
7 public debt in an amount not to exceed ~~\$387,646,600~~ \$430,246,600 for this purpose.

8 **SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.**
