2001 WISCONSIN ACT 12

AN ACT *to amend* 20.866 (2) (y) of the statutes; **relating to:** state purchase of a Justice Center building and granting bonding authority.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.866 (2) (y) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.866 (2) (y) Building commission; housing state departments and agencies. From the capital improvement fund, a sum sufficient to the building commission for the purpose of housing state departments and agencies. The state may contract public debt in an amount not to exceed \$387,646,600 \$430,246,600 for this purpose.

SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) 1999–2001 STATE BUILDING PROGRAM ADDITION. In 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, section 9107 (1), the following project is added to the 1999–2001 state building program and the appropriate totals are increased by the amounts shown:

(a) In paragraph (a) 1., under projects financed by program revenue supported borrowing:

Justice Center purchase — Madison
