Please draft an amendment to AB 61 that, on pg 3, ln 17, replaces the sentence beginning with ""The nongovernmental issuing agent..." with language that directs the department to promulgate a procedure for forwarding application materials to the department that will best serve the applicant .

This amendment is in response to testimony that nongovernmental agents may fail to forward materials in a timely manner. The intent of the amendment is to provide the department with the directive and ability to create a system that might better assure prompt service for the applicant.
