

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2001 SENATE BILL 279**

October 16, 2001 – Offered by Representative BOYLE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 20: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 4g. Nonstatutory provisions; elimination of partisan caucus**
4 **staffs.**”

5 (1) (a) The authorized FTE positions for the assembly, funded from the
6 appropriation under section 20.765 (1) (a) of the statutes, are decreased on January
7 1, 2002, by the number equal to the number of FTE positions assigned to the
8 assembly party caucuses on September 1, 2001, minus 3.0, to eliminate staffing of
9 party caucuses in the assembly.

10 (b) The authorized FTE positions for the senate, funded from the appropriation
11 under section 20.765 (1) (b) of the statutes, are decreased on January 1, 2002, by the
12 number equal to the number of FTE positions assigned to the senate party caucuses

1 on September 1, 2001, minus 3.0, to eliminate staffing of party caucuses in the
2 senate.”.
